To get onto Teams:

- Download the **Microsoft Teams app** on your laptop, tablet or smartphone
- Log in with your school username (your first initial, a full stop, your last name and the school email address ending. Example: **h.jones@grampian.derby.sch.uk**)
- Remember your password has a capital letter and a number. Example: **Grampian1**

Your class teacher will call on a **Wednesday** afternoon to catch up. They will talk about:

- Things you've been doing at home
- How you've found the learning
- If you are managing to get on all your accounts
- How you parents are finding the home learning
