Our Curriculum



Each morning your child will have a set routine of sessions, which cover Grampian's core curriculum subjects of Spelling, Reading, Writing and Maths. In the afternoons, your child will explore different wider curriculum subjects such as Science, P.E. and topic subjects including History, Geography and Art.

Each term the teaching team devise a context to teach these subjects and, for this term, we are learning about the Victorians. We are going to be learning all about what it was like to live in the Victorian era in addition to learning about some very important people from that period and looking at what they did.
