Key Information

Timetable:

Children will have extended time in continuous provision where they will be engaged in child-initiated learning. Each day there will also be phonics and maths adult-led inputs in smaller groups along with key-worker time which will include story telling and communication focus.

What to bring:

Children will need to bring in a labelled coat and wellies. Reception age children will also be given a water bottle and book bag and Nursery age children can provide a water bottle for school.

Tapestry:

We will be using Tapestry to upload pictures of your child's learning. You will be given a login for this upon your child starting at our setting.

In September our topic will be 'All About Me'. As part of our learning and discussions we will talk about ourselves, our families and what makes us special.

Please could you send your child in with a family photo on their first day. This can be put up in the classroom so children have some familiarity whilst they ae settling in.
